President Dan and Vice President Jay couldn't make the meeting and Treasurer Don was busy in the kitchen so Secretary Kitti led the meeting.

Lee Ann said the Walk/Run was a success with 155 sign ups with 15 who didn't pick up their shirts. We were down about \$1,300 in sponsors but we still raised between \$4,000 and \$5,000. Final figures will be available soon. Shirts are still available for \$5. Sizes are youth large, medium, large, 2X and 3X. Just let me or Lee Ann know if you want a shirt. Nancy Jo asked Bob M. if the Walk/Run will continue now that Nicolet Plastics has been sold. Bob said it will. Also, a huge thank you to everyone who volunteered during the morning of the race, put up posters, put together packets and handed out packets at Tri Fitness to make it a success.

After expenses, we raised about \$170 selling ice cream at the Muscle Maniacs car show. A donation to Muscle Maniacs was discussed as they normally charge vendors \$10 to have a booth at the show. Since we already donated a trophy and since they know that we give money back to the community, the car show officers do not expect us to make a donation. Before next year's show, we will discuss if we want to donate towards the show.

It was decided to re-join the Lakewood Chamber of Commerce. Kitti has received the dues notice and will ask Treasurer Don for a \$75 check.

We received a request for money from the Friends of Lakewood Townsend Ambulance Service to help pay for their soon-to-be-obsolete cardiac monitors. They are

Also included is an all-you-can-eat buffet with two drinks (rail mixers, beer, soda or water), a T-Rats-themed Jimmy Buffett t-shirt, a post-game concert put on by the Boat Drunks and fireworks. We will have a float in the Townsend 4th of July parade and the July 16th Lakewood Mardi Gras parade. Townsend's theme is "Don't Worry. Be Happy in the Northwoods." Bob M. will add that song to our play list, if possible. More float and parade information will be forthcoming from President Dan.
